

BIRD CHECKLIST

OASIS OF MARA

29 PALMS INN

In 1929 the Oasis of Mara was described as a fan palm oasis with four ponds which regularly overflowed about a half mile to the north out into the desert. We now know that the Oasis of Mara formed along the Pinto Mountain Faultline approximately 9,400 years ago and water has been available since then. Undoubtedly, birds immediately found this water source. During the 1950s water along the eastern end of the oasis had receded beneath the ground while at the Inn 4 ponds formed during the winter and 2 during the summer. Today the greenery associated with the oasis is still available along the mile long fault line and the remaining pond at the 29 Palms Inn' continues to provide sanctuary and moisture for numerous resident and migratory birds species.

This checklist is not meant to be all-inclusive, but a quick look at what one might expect to find (those shown as C for common), as you stroll around the grounds of the Inn or take the Oasis Of Mara Nature trail from the Visitor Center. Of course, certain times of year more migrants will be observed. *Please report any sightings of species not on the list.*

Reference letters following bird names indicate the following:

C=common regularly seen

U=uncommon species occurring regularly, but infrequently seen

R=rare species seen only in small numbers or not on a regular basis

X=extremely rare or accidental occurrence **M**=migrants, spring and fall, staying in winter **Wi**, and summer **Su**, some to nest

V=vagrant, temporarily on location from another more suitable habitat

RES=year round resident

N=nesting species
