Position Overview

Bussers at the 29 Palms Inn restaurant prepare the dining room for service, ensuring the dining room setting is clean and organized, and tables are set and ready to receive guests. Throughout service bussers will assist servers by removing used tableware between courses, helping bring out food when needed, and efficiently clear, clean, and reset tables once guests are done.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Greet our guests in a cheerful and polite manner upon their arrival, and thank them for dining with us upon departure
- Serve water (by request), bread, butter, and other requests by guests
- When needed, assist servers with bringing out orders and replenishing water
- Carry dirty dishes from dining room to kitchen/dish washing station
- Maintain the overall cleanliness of dining room, pool patio, and tent space by sweeping, mopping, dusting, cleaning windows, chairs, tables, etc.
- Clean counters, shelves, walls, furniture, or equipment in food service areas or other areas of the restaurant, sweep and mop floors
- Maintain adequate supplies of items such as clean linens, silverware, glassware, dishes, and trays, ensuring service runs smoothly.

- Wash and sanitize dishes, pots, and pans for the dining room and kitchen
- Wipe table tops, chairs, salt and pepper shakers and sugar caddies with sanitized damp cloth between seating's
- Replace soiled table linens and sets tables with clean coordinating linens, silverware and glassware
- Maintain cleanliness & organization of kitchen/dish washing station by washing and putting away dishes and taking out the trash
- All other duties as assigned
